Salta has been the Workers' Party stronghold since 2000. Trotskyism won a seat for the Lower House and reached 28.39 percent in Salta city, becoming the most-voted front.

The Radical Party (UCR) had been sent off of the Tucuman's political stage but it recovered and won two seats out of possible four, and took the Capital, where Fuerza Republicana, founded by the genocide perpetrator Antonio Domingo Bussi, received almost 10 percent.

Vaca Muerta, a huge shale oil and gas formation, is in Neuquén's Añelo deparment. Anti-Kirchnerite and Hugo Moyano ally Guillermo Pereyra won by a wide margin there with more than 55 percent while the Kirchnerite Senate candidate won about 20 percent of the

Cristina Kirchner's "place in the world," Calafate, is located in Lago Argentino district. With 52.82 percent, Kirchnerism doubled its provincial support there.
